COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Cat, Inc. d/b/a Coach's Corner (hereinafter, "Cat, Inc." or "Licensee"), License No. 2600101038, do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative
Action are set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing
Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

- 1. Nicholas A. Revon, III ("Revon") has 25% ownership interest in Cat, Inc. d/b/a Coach's Corner ("Cat, Inc.").
 - 2. On May 21, 2005, Revon married Alida Bevier ("Bevier").
- 3. Cat, Inc. did not notify the Division of Revon's marriage to Bevier until submitting a Personal History Questionnaire for Bevier in October of 2007.
- 4. On October 19, 2007, the Division forwarded a 10-day Demand Letter to the Licensee demanding that it submit additional required suitability documents for Bevier, as well as a copy of the marriage certificate. The Demand Letter was mailed, via certified mail, to 2221 Transcontinental Drive, Metairie, Louisiana 70001, and 917 Tyler Avenue, Harahan, Louisiana 70123. On November 7, 2007, delivery of the letter was accepted at 2221 Transcontinental Drive, Metairie, Louisiana 70001. On November 6, 2007, Nicholas Revon, III, accepted delivery of the letter at 917 Tyler Avenue, Harahan, Louisiana 70123.
- 5. In response to the Division's demand, the licensee timely submitted the requested suitability documents. However, a copy of the marriage certificate was not provided to the Division until April 1, 2008.
- 6. The Licensee does admit it violated LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(4) and LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(i).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Licensee shall pay a civil penalty of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the violation of LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(4) and Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for

the violation of LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(i), for a total civil penalty of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

- 2. The Division hereby agrees to accept the payment of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty, and in connection with any future assessments of the Licensee's suitability.
- 4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Licensee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.
- 7. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Licensee must pay One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure

to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and

terms and conditions hereof.
