

# JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

#### ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

- 1. the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Video Gaming Division (hereinafter "Division"), and
- 2. Mike Rider d/b/a Mike Rider, License No. 1000604786 (hereinafter "licensee"),

who respectfully represent the following:

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. On or about March 01, 2003, the Division mailed licensee an Annual Licensee Form via United State Postal Service which indicated within the letter that the licensee was required to summit the appropriate licensing fee and tax clearance certificates no later than July 1<sup>st</sup>; on or about June 1, 2003, the Division mailed a reminder notice to the Licensee of its obligation to submit the fees and tax clearances by July 1, 2003; On or about June 27, 2003 the licensee submitted to the Division its Annual Form, fee, and state tax clearance certificate; however, the Licensee failed to submit the appropriate local tax clearance certificate; on or about July 9, 2003, the Division sent a third notice advising licensee of its failure to submit the local tax clearance; on or about July 16, 2003 the Division received the Licensee's local tax clearance certificate;
- 2. The licensee is mandated by I.AC 42:XI.2405(B)(7) to submit proof of current tax filings and payments, including tax clearance certificates from the state and all appropriate local taxing authorities to the division along with the annual fee as provided in Subsection B.4 no later than July 1 of each year;
- 3. On or about August 25, 2003, the Division issued Violation/Inspection Report #014457, citing violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(7). Attendant to this Violation/Inspection Report, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice

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4. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on December 2, 2003 at 9:00 a.m. before the Honorable William II. Brown.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the licensee hereby propose the following settlement, that:

- 1. The licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(7) in that it failed to submit proof of current tax filings from appropriate local taxing authorities to the division no later than July 1 of the current year;
- In consideration of the previous and aforementioned settlement of Violation/Inspection Report #14457 and in lieu of further administrative action against the licensee's video gaming license, the licensee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;
- 3. The Division hereby agrees to accept the licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of Violation/Inspection Report No. 14457 and this Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action:
- 4. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
- 5. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
- 6. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Mike Rider d/b/a Mike Rider pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
- 7. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the licensee being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled; and
- 8. The Division and the licensee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.
