NOW COMES the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and CHC Port Allen, LLC d/b/a Crazy Horse Caberet (hereinafter, "Licensee"), who file this Joint Motion for Approval of Compromise and Settlement Agreement, and in support thereof would respectively show unto the Hearing Officer as follows:

COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and CHC Port Allen d/b/a Crazy Horse Caberet (hereinafter, "Licensee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Violation/Inspection Report to the Licensee, which Violation/Inspection Report contains allegations of a certain violation of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issue raised by the said Violation/Inspection Report, are set for hearing June 9, 2014, before the Louisiana Garning Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Violation/Inspection Report;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. On March 20, 2014, the Division conducted an underage compliance inspections in West Baton Rouge Parish; whereby, the Licensee was one of the establishments investigated.

- During the course of the Division's investigation of the Licensee, one of the
 Licensee's employees allowed an underage patron to play a video gaming device and cashed out
 the underage patron's payout ticket.
- 3. The Licensee stipulates that it allowed an underage patron to play a video gaming device and subsequently cashed out the underage patron's payout ticket.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Garning Control Board, the Licensee shall pay ONE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS for the violation of La. R.S. 27:443.
- 2. The Division hereby agrees that payment of a civil penalty of ONE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS shall be in full and final settlement of all matters set forth in the Violation/ Inspection Report for the Licensee's violation of La. R.S. 27:443.
- 3. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Licensee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty, and in connection with any future assessments of the Licensee's suitability.
- 6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this

proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full bearing on the merits.

7. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Licensee must pay ONE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

8. The Licensee hereby informs the hearing office and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board that it has taken steps to insure a violation of this type does not recur in the future by placing a card reader at the entrance of the establishment. The Licensee will require all patrons to swipe a driver's license card in order to gain entrance into the establishment. The device is designed to read the driver's license and immediately inform the Licensee whether the patron is of appropriate legal age to enter the video poker establishment.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
