



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**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

1. the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "Division"), and
2. Lucky Magnolia Truck Stop & Casino d/b/a Lucky Magnolia Truck Stop & Casino, VGL No. 4600511567 (hereinafter "Licensee"),

who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

1. On April 16, 2004, a division agent observed a billboard on LA. 16 southbound, advertising the Lucky Magnolia Truck Plaza & Casino, which is located at 40235 Highway 16, Denham Springs, Louisiana. The required toll-free telephone number for problem gambling was included but in lettering too small to be read by passing motorists. The division agent issued violation/inspection report No. 14400;
2. The Licensee is mandated by La. R.S. 27:27.3 to place the toll-free telephone number of the National Council on Problem Gambling (or other similar, Board-approved toll-free telephone number) in any advertisement of its gaming activities or gaming establishment;
3. Pursuant to its agent's observations, the Division issued Violation/Inspection Report #14400 to the Licensee on or about April 19, 2004, citing violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3;
4. On or about August 26, 2004, the Licensee submitted photographs to the Division showing the billboard had been altered and currently included the toll-free number in larger print. The Division subsequently inspected the billboard and determined that it was legible by passing motorists;

5. Attendant to Violation/Inspection Report #14400, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to the licensee on or about October 21, 2004;
6. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on December 7, 2004 at 9:00 a.m. before the Honorable William H. Brown to address the period of non-compliance.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the Licensee hereby propose the following settlement, that:

1. The Licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3, in that; due to the small size of the lettering, the required problem gambling toll-free telephone number was illegible on the advertisement signs observed April 16, 2004;
2. In lieu of further administrative action against the Licensee's video gaming license, the Licensee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;
3. The Division hereby agrees to accept the Licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of Violation/Inspection Report No. 14400 and this Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;
4. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
5. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
6. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Lucky Magnolia Truck Plaza & Casino d/b/a Lucky Magnolia Truck Plaza & Casino pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
7. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the Licensee being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled until such time as the penalty is paid in full; and


8. The Division and the Licensee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.



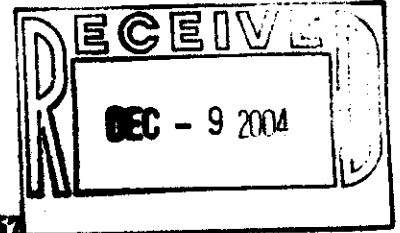

Considering the foregoing Joint Motion For Entry of Stipulations and Approval of Proposed Settlement, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that such proposed settlement be approved, to wit:

1. the Licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3, in that, due to the illegibility of the toll-free hotline phone number, the required problem gambling toll-free telephone number was illegible on signs advertising its gaming establishment;
2. the Licensee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;
3. payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; and
4. the failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the Licensee being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled until such time as the penalty is paid in full.
