
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
A true and correct copy of the proposed Compromise and Settlement Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference for all purposes.

**COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The Louisiana State Police, Gaming Enforcement Division (hereinafter, the "Division") and Burrito's Grille, LLC d/b/a Burrito's Grille (hereinafter, the "Licensee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board (the "Board") has sent a Notice of Recommendation of Revocation to Licensee, which Notice contains allegations of certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the issues raised by said Notice are set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office on April 15, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with said Notice;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

**STIPULATIONS**

1. The Licensee is a Type 2 licensed establishment located at 7009 Read Blvd., New Orleans, Louisiana 70127.

2. On or about April 1, 2025, the Division electronically mailed a courtesy letter to the Licensee informing them of the requirement to submit the annual fee and forms no later than July 1, 2025.

3. The Licensee failed to submit its annual fee and forms by the July 1, 2025, deadline and for several months thereafter.

4. On November 25, 2025, the Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Revocation, which detailed the Licensee's right to request an administrative hearing with the Hearing Officer and set forth the consequences for failure to do so.

5. The Licensee failed to timely request an administrative hearing with the Hearing Officer.

6. On January 6, 2026, the Board issued a Notice of Revocation, revoking the Type 2 video draw poker gaming license of the Licensee.

7. On January 23, 2026, the Licensee filed a motion requesting a rehearing or reconsideration of the Notice of Revocation.

8. On February 26, 2026, the Board considered the Licensee's motion for rehearing, granted its rehearing request, and forwarded the matter to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office.

9. On February 26, 2026, the Division received the Licensee's required annual forms and fee, and received supplemental documents on March 26, 2026.

10. Following the Licensee's submission and Division's processing of all required documents, the Division filed a Motion to Convert the Recommendation of Revocation to an Administrative Action on April 8, 2026.

11. The Licensee failed to timely submit the required annual fee and supporting documents, in violation of La. R.S. 27:435(A)(6), La. R.S. 27:435(H)(3), La. R.S. 27:435(K)(4)(a) and (d), and LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(a) and (b).

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. In lieu of administrative action, Licensee will pay a penalty of **ONE THOUSAND and FIVE HUNDRED and 00/100 (\$1,500.00) DOLLARS** for its violation of La. R.S. 27:435(A)(6), La. R.S. 27:435(H)(3), La. R.S. 27:435(K)(4)(a) and (d), and LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(a) and (b).

2. The Division hereby agrees that payment of a total penalty of **ONE THOUSAND and FIVE HUNDRED and 00/100 (\$1,500.00) DOLLARS** shall be in full and final settlement of all matters set forth in the Notice of Recommendation of Revocation.

3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this admitted violation in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of Licensee's suitability.

4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.


5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Licensee, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory,

but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.


7. If approved, Licensee agrees to make full payment of the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Licensee agrees that failure to meet this requirement shall result in immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.
