DECISION OF THE LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

IN RE: MARY'S BUBBLE TEA, INC. D/B/A BUBBLE CAFÉ NO. 2600214664

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by Mary's Bubble Tea, Inc. d/b/a Bubble Café, License No. 2600214664, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated June 5, 2013, in which he revoked Bubble Café's video gaming license because Sinh T. Nguyen, officer and 5% owner of the licensee, is delinquent in the filing or payment of state taxes.

The licensee, in its memorandum in support of appeal, alleges that Sinh Nguyen is no longer associated with Mary's Bubble Tea, Inc. and, therefore, no longer required to meet suitability. This is not part of the record and cannot be considered.

We will remand this matter to the Hearing Officer for the introduction of evidence supporting this allegation. He will then consider any new evidence and render a decision accordingly which may include revocation or the imposition of a civil penalty for failure of an owner to maintain suitability.
