A true and correct copy of the proposed Compromise and Settlement Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference for all purposes.



**COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Michael I. Soileau (hereinafter, "Permittee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has sent a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Permittee, which Notice contains allegations of certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the issues raised by said Notice are set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office on Tuesday, January 6, 2015, at 9:30 a.m.

**WHEREAS**, the Division and Permittee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with said Notice;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

**STIPULATIONS**

1. By renewal application dated May 28, 2014, Permittee sought approval of a non-key gaming employee renewal application from the Division. A background investigation was performed and a permit was granted with an expiration date of August 16, 2016.

2. On or about October 27, 2014, State Police Criminal Records notified the Division of Permittee's October 22, 2014 arrest. Permittee was arrested by the East Baton Rouge Parish Sheriff's Office and charged with violation of La. R.S. 14:98, Operating a Vehicle While Intoxicated (misdemeanor) and La. R.S. 32:61, Maximum Speed Limit.

3. Permittee failed to timely notify the Division of his arrest as required by gaming law.

### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. In lieu of administrative action, the Permittee will pay a penalty of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY and No/100 (\$250.00) DOLLARS for his violation of LAC 42:III.2901(B)(4).

2. The Division hereby agrees that payment of a penalty of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY and No/100 (\$250.00) DOLLARS shall be in full and final settlement of all matters set forth in the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.

3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this admitted violation in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of Permittee's suitability.

4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Permittee, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.


6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this

proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

7. If approved, Permittee agrees to make full payment of the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Permittee agrees that failure to meet this requirement shall result in immediate suspension of the gaming permit without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
