COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereafter the "Division"), and Jerri A. Boxer (hereafter sometimes referred to as the "Permittee") do hereby and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Revocation, Order of Immediate Emergency Suspension, and Notice of Hearing dated January 31, 2013, to Jerri A. Boxer (hereafter sometimes referred to as "the Notice") alleging certain violations of the Louisiana Gaming Control Law;

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the Notice were set for a Revocation Hearing on May 6, 2013, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office;

WHEREAS, at the May 6, 2013, Revocation Hearing the parties entered into a stipulation on the record, which will be further memorialized by this writing; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Permittee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the Notice;

NOW, THEREFORE, and in consideration of the foregoing, the parties do hereby agree:

STIPULATIONS

- 1. On or about January 5, 2013, a complaint was submitted to the Casino Manager of L'Auberge du Lac Casino Lake Charles with respect to employee Jerri A. Boxer making a statement to a fellow employee that he was going to come to work and shoot several people.
- 2. On January 6, 2013, the Casino Manager met with Jerri A. Boxer with regard to the complaint mentioned under Paragraph 1 above, wherein Jerri A. Boxer admitted to making the statement that he was going to come to work and shoot several people
- 3. On January 8, 2013, Jerri A. Boxer was arrested by the Louisiana Office of State Police for violating La. R.S 14:40.1 (Terrorizing).
- 4. On February 27, 2013, the District Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial District rejected the charge of Terrorizing (La. R.S. 14:40.1) then pending against Jerri A. Boxer.
 - 5. Jerri A. Boxer has requested to surrender his Non-Key Gaming Employee Permit.
- 6. The Division has agreed to accept the surrender of Jerri A. Boxer's Non-Key Gaming Employee Permit, subject to the following Terms and Conditions

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. In lieu of a hearing on the recommended revocation of Jerri A. Boxer's Non-Key Gaming Employee Permit, Jerri A. Boxer shall be allowed to surrender his Non-Key Gaming Employee Permit.
- 2. Jerri A. Boxer will not be eligible to apply for any approval authorized by the Louisiana Gaming Control Law, either individually or as a shareholder, member, managing member, partner, revenue, profit or income interest holder, or as a person who, in the opinion of the Board or Division may exercise significant influence over the operations of a Louisiana gaming licensee, operator or permittee, for a period of sixty (60) months from the date of the approval of this agreement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

- Jerri A. Boxer, by affixing his signature on this Compromise and Settlement
 Agreement, acknowledges these prohibitions on behalf of himself.
- 4. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration the violations alleged in the Notice in connection with any future violation(s), assessment of penalty or determination of the suitability of Jerri A. Boxer.
- 5. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Jerri A. Boxer, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed Compromise and Settlement Agreement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board no sooner than its regularly scheduled monthly meeting for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the proposed revocation action pending against the Non-Key Gaming Employee Permit of Jerri A. Boxer will be dismissed, Jerri A. Boxer will be allowed to surrender his Non-Key Gaming Employee Permit and Jerri A. Boxer will not be eligible to apply for any approval authorized by the Louisiana Gaming Control Law, either individually or as a shareholder, member, managing member, partner, revenue, profit or income interest holder, or as a person who, in the opinion of the Board or Division may exercise significant influence over the

operations of a Louisiana gaming licensee, operator or permittee, for a period of sixty (60) months.

8. The Division and Permittee waive their rights to appeal this Compromise and Settlement Agreement if the Order approving this Compromise and Settlement Agreement is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.
