# JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

#### ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

- The Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police.
   Casino Gaming Division ("Division"), and
- 2. Louisiana I Gaming d/b/a Boomtown Belle Casino, ("Boomtown"), who respectfully represent the following:

#### WHEREAS:

- Boomtown failed to comply with requirements for the securing and the surveillance of sensitive keys. As a result, restrictive sensitive keys were kept in single lock boxes and without required camera surveillance.
- 2. Boomtown failed to control restricted sensitive keys as prescribed in licensee internal control procedures, in doing so, they failed to use appropriate security measures for the maintenance of sensitive restrictive keys.
- 3. Boomtown agrees that it failed to implement procedures to reasonably insure that restricted sensitive keys were subject to the appropriate security surveillance, and that restrictive sensitive keys, as listed in the licensee's internal controls, are placed in the appropriate lock box which is a violation of LAC 42:XIII.2715A(8) and (10).
- 4. Boomtown has implemented policies, procedures and controls to assure that restricted sensitive keys are subject to camera surveillance and that sensitive keys are secured in the appropriate lock box.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the foregoing Stipulations, the Division and Boomtown hereby propose the following settlement:

- 1. Boomtown admits that it was in violation of LAC 42:XIII.2715A (8) and (10).
- 2. Consistent with two violations of LAC 42:XIII.2715 A (8) and (10). Boomtown agrees to pay a civil penalty in the amount of twenty thousand dollars (\$20.000) in full and final settlement of Notice of Violation and Penalty CGD010131
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this violation in connection with any future violation.
- 4. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 5. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Boomtown pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties.
- 6. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalty must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board.
- 7. The failure of Boomtown to submit payment within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall constitute an additional violation of Louisiana gaming laws and regulations.

8. The Division and Boomtown waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.

- 3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Louisiana I Gaming, d/b/a Boomtown Belle Casino shall pay civil penalty of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) due within fifteen days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.
