JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

- 1. The Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Casino Gaming Division ("Division"), and
- 2. Treasure Chest Casino L.L.C., ("Treasure Chest"), who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

- Treasure Chest failed to maintain an accurate inventory and count of sensitive keys transferred between shifts. In addition, Treasure Chest failed to maintain an inventory of sensitive keys by key rings and to individually list sensitive keys as required by regulations.
- 2. Treasure Chest reclassified sensitive keys to nonsensitive keys without Division approval.
- 3. Treasure Chest failed to properly maintain sign out logs for accessing secure areas.
- 4. Treasure Chest has implemented policies, procedures and controls to assure that restricted sensitive keys are appropriately accounted for and that sensitive and restrictive sensitive keys are accountable to Treasure Chest and the Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing Stipulations, the Division and Treasure Chest hereby propose the following settlement:

- Treasure Chest admits that it was in violation of LAC 42:XIII.2715(A)(1); LAC 42:XIII.2715(A)(10); LAC 42:XIII.2723(P)(1); LAC 42:XIII.2723(Q)(31); LAC 42:XIII.2717(L)(6)(a).
- 2. Consistent with above-numerated violations, Treasure Chest agrees to pay a civil penalty in the amount of fifty-eight thousand dollars (\$58,000) in full and final settlement of Notice of Violation and Penalty RGS010130.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this violation in connection with any future violation.
- 4. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 5. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Treasure Chest pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties.
- 6. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalty must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board.

- 7. The failure of Treasure Chest to submit payment within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall constitute an additional violation of Louisiana gaming laws and regulations.
- 8. The Division and Treasure Chest waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.

- 3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Treasure Chest Casino, L.L.C. shall pay civil penalty-of Fifty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$58,000.00) due within fifteen days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.
