

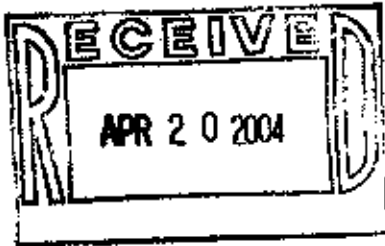

JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:


1. the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Video Gaming Division (hereinafter "Division"), and
2. H.L. Enterprises d/b/a Sharpie's The Club House, VGL. No. 0904113299 (hereinafter "licensee"),

who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

1. On or about November 13, 2003, a printed advertisement for Sharpie's The Club House was observed in the November 2003 issue of *City Lights* magazine by a division agent. This advertisement, which mentioned The Club offered video poker, failed to include the required toll-free telephone number for problem gambling;
2. The licensee is mandated by La. R.S. 27:27.3 to place the toll-free telephone number of the National Council on Problem Gambling (or other similar, Board-approved toll-free telephone number) in any advertisement of its gaming activities or gaming establishment;
3. Pursuant to its agent's observations, the Division issued Violation/Inspection Report #012663 to the licensee on or about November 13, 2003, citing violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3. Attendant to Violation/Inspection Report #012663, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to the licensee on or about February 11, 2004;
4. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on April 13, 2004 at 9:30 a.m. before the Honorable Joseph E. Anzalone, Jr.;


NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the licensee hereby propose the following settlement, that:

1. The licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3, in that it did not place the required problem gambling toll-free telephone number on its advertisement observed on November 13, 2003;
2. In lieu of further administrative action against the licensee's video gaming license, the licensee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;
3. The Division hereby agrees to accept the licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of Violation/Inspection Report No. 012663 and this Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;
4. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
5. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
6. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and H.L. Enterprises d/b/a Sharpie's The Club House, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
7. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the licensee being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled until such time as the penalty is paid in full; and
8. The Division and the licensee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.


ORDER

Considering the foregoing Joint Motion for Entry of Stipulations and Approval of Proposed Settlement, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that such proposed settlement be approved, to wit:

1. the licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3, in that it did not include the required problem gambling toll-free telephone number in the magazine advertisement that advertised its gaming establishment;
2. the licensee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;
3. payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; and
4. the failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the licensee being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled until such time as the penalty is paid in full.



Carl Pendley

Carl Pendley has been maintaining and informing the Act-La-Tax television viewers at his anchor desk in KSLA TV Channel 12 since 1979. His face and voice is highly recognizable to us all, and he does a great job covering the news.

Carl's birthplace is Lubbock, Texas, where he graduated from Texas Tech University with honors. Carl had always been interested in drama and acting in high school. He began majoring in drama at Texas Tech, but during his senior year, he switched his major to telecommunications. He also took his first job in television at Lubbock's ABC affiliate that year.
