COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State

Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Pirogue's Café, LLC d/b/a Pirogue's Cafe do hereby

represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Division has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Revocation to

Pirogue's Café, LLC d/b/a Pirogue's Cafe alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming

Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Revocation

were set for hearing on August 17, 2009, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board

Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Pirogue's Café, LLC d/b/a Pirogue's Cafe are desirous of

fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in

connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Revocation;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby

agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

On January 19, 2009, the Louisiana State Police, Gaming Division conducted a 1.

compliance inspection of Pirogue's Café, LLC d/b/a Pirogue's Cafe.

- 2. During the inspection, it was discovered that the Licensee had allowed its ATC permit to expire on April 30, 2008.
- 3. On January 26, 2009, the Licensee notified the Division that it had renewed its ATC permit and forwarded the valid permit to the Division. The effective dates of the new permit are May 1, 2008 through April 30, 2009.
- 4. Pirogue's Café, LLC d/b/a Pirogue's Café failed to maintain a valid ATC permit and operated its video gaming devices for approximately eight months without the permit.
- 5. During this time the Licensee received net device revenue in the amount of \$4,280.53.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Pirogue's Café, LLC d/b/a Pirogue's Cafe will pay a civil penalty of TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED and No/100 (\$2,100.00) DOLLARS.
- 2. The Division will dismiss the Notice of Recommendation of Revocation.
- 3. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this Compromise and Settlement, Pirogue's Café, LLC d/b/a Pirogue's Cafe shall remit payment of the above referenced penalty to the Division.
- 4. The Division hereby agrees to accept Pirogue's Café, LLC d/b/a Pirogue's Cafe's payment of the above stated TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED and No/100 (\$2,100.00) DOLLAR penalty in full and final settlement.
- 5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of the Licensee's suitability.
- 6. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 7. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Pirogue's Café, LLC d/b/a Pirogue's Cafe, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 8. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits. Failure

to pay the penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement, and to comply with each term and condition listed herein, shall result in the immediate suspension of the Pirogue's Café, LLC d/b/a Pirogue's Cafe license without the necessity of further administrative action, until such time as the penalty is paid in full and Pirogue's Café, LLC d/b/a Pirogue's Cafe is in compliance with all terms and conditions.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
