## DECISION OF THE LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

IN RE: VIVIAN T. WILSON P040003084

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by Vivian T. Wilson, Permit No. P040003084, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated August 25, 2014, in which he revoked Ms. Wilson's non-key gaming employee permit because of a pending charge of theft of goods.

Ms. Wilson, in her appeal, alleges that the charge was reduced to disturbing the peace.

She pled guilty to the reduced charge. She asks that the Hearing Officer's decision be reversed.

Any evidence relating to the subsequent action regarding the theft charge is not part of the record and cannot be considered.

We will remand this matter to the Hearing Officer for the introduction of any new evidence. He will consider the new evidence and render a decision accordingly. Either party may then appeal.

## **ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED THAT this matter be REMANDED for the purpose and reasons set forth in this decision.
