COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter the "Division") and The Teche Lounge, LLC d/b/a The Teche Lounge, License No. 5000114421 (hereinafter "Licensee") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Revocation, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Revocation;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. The Licensee stipulates that it was delinquent in the filing and/or payment of Louisiana state income taxes on behalf of The Teche Lounge and Remi Gardemal, its 100% owner, as required by Louisiana Gaming Control Law.
2. The Licensee stipulates that on November 5, 2010, it received a 30-day letter by certified mail from the Division stating that The Teche Lounge and Remi Gardemal had 30 days

within which to become current in the filing and/or payment of their Louisiana state income taxes.

3. The Division stipulates that it granted the Licensee's request for an extension time to remedy its tax delinquencies by allowing the Licensee 20 extra days within which to become current in the filing and/or payment of their Louisiana state income taxes.

4. The Division stipulates that it did not receive a Louisiana Department of Revenue tax clearance for The Teche Lounge and Remi Gardemal until July 22, 2011, which was after the 20 day extension allowed by the Division.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Licensee shall pay FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$500.00) for the violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(1)(b).

2. The Division hereby agrees to accept a FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$500.00) penalty for the Licensee's violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(1)(b).

3. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.


4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Licensee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.



6. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee must pay FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$500.00) within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the Licensee's Type 1 video poker license, without the necessity of any further administrative action, until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
