**DECISION OF THE
LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD**

**IN RE: TERRYTOWN CAFÉ, INC.
D/B/A TERRYTOWN CAFE
NO. 2600207442**

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by Terrytown Café d/b/a Terrytown Café, No. 2600207442, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated July 10, 2024, wherein its Type 2 Video Poker license was revoked. The basis of the revocation was the failure of the licensee to hold a valid Alcohol and Tobacco ("ATC") permit.

The licensee now alleges that it has obtained a valid ATC permit. Any new evidence is not part of the record and cannot be considered.

The Board remands this matter to the Hearing Officer for the introduction of evidence regarding the ATC permit. The Hearing Officer will consider all evidence and render a decision accordingly. Either party may then appeal.

ORDER

This matter having been considered by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board in open meeting of September 19, 2024:

IT IS ORDERED THAT this matter be **REMANDED** for the purpose and reasons set forth in this decision.
