NOW COMES the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Permittee, NATIONAL NETWORKS, LLC (hereinafter, "PERMITTEE"), who file this Joint Motion for Approval of Compromise and Settlement Agreement, and in support thereof would respectively show unto the Hearing Officer as follows:

COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and NATIONAL NETWORKS, LLC Permit No. P081002206 (hereinafter, "Permittee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty are set for hearing on June 25, 2008, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Permittee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

- On January 3, 2008, the Division issued, via U.S. mail, an Annual Affidavit form to the permittee. The permittee was to submit the Annual Affidavit and the annual permit fee by March 28, 2008, which represents the anniversary date of its Non-Gaming Supplier Permit.
- 2. On January 22, 2008, the Division mailed, via U.S. mail, an URGENT REMINDER to the permittee.
- 3. On April 21, 2008, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty to the permittee alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.
- 4. On May 7, 2008, the permittee submitted its Annual Affidavit and annual permit fee to the Division.
 - 5. The permittee does admit it violated La. R.S. 27:29(I) and La. R.S. 27:29(F).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the permittee shall pay a civil penalty of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the violation of La. R.S 27:29.3(F) and Sixty two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$62.50) pursuant to La. R.S. 27:29.5, for a total of Five Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$562.50)
- 2. The Division hereby agrees to accept the payment of Five Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$562.50) in full and final settlement of the Notice of Suspension and Penalty.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty, and in connection with any future assessments of the permittee's suitability.

- 4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the permittee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.
- 7. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the permittee must pay Five Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$562.50) within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the gaming permit without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
