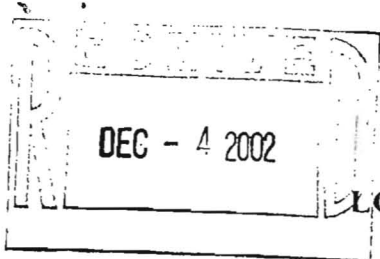

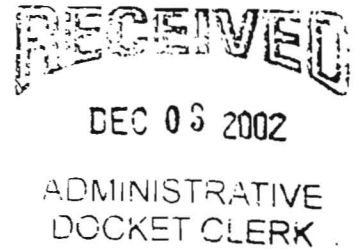

JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATION AND APPROVAL OF
PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

On Joint Motion of:

- (i) the State of Louisiana, Office of State Police, Casino Gaming Division ("Division"), and
 - (ii) Boyd Racing, LLC d/b/a Delta Downs Racetrack and Casino "DDRC",
- who enter the following Stipulations into the record:

1.

On or about February 14, 2002, two underage persons gained access to the designated gaming area of "DDRC".

2.

On or about February 16, 2002, one underage person gained access to the designated gaming area of DDRC.

3.

DDRC security personnel failed to make the required entries in the security logs regarding the access of the designated gaming area by the underage persons.


NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the forgoing Stipulations, the Division and DDRC hereby propose the following settlement:


- (1) DDRC does admit to violations of LAC 42:VII.2915 A and violations of LAC 42:VII.3309 B.
 - (2) DDRC will pay a civil penalty of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40, 000).
 - (3) The Division hereby agrees to accept DDRC's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of CGD020168.
 - (4) This Stipulation and Settlement is to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
 - (5) This Stipulation and Settlement constitute the entire agreement between the Division and DDRC pertaining to the subject matter contained, herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties.
 - (6) This Stipulation and Settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if these proposed Stipulations and Settlement are approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, payment of the above penalty must be submitted within fifteen (15) days of this approval to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

(7) Division and DDRC waive their rights to appeal this Stipulation and Settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUGED AND DECREED, that the admission of DDRC to violations of LAC 42:VII.2915 A and LAC 42:VII.3309 B be accepted;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUGED AND DECREED, that Boyd Racing, LLC d/b/a Delta Downs Racetrack and Casino shall pay as a civil penalty to the State of Louisiana the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000) within fifteen days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.
