COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police ("the Division") and Louisiana Interest, Inc. d/b/a Oz ("Licensee"), VGL 3601103654, do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Louisiana Interest, Inc. d/b/a Oz, which notice alleges certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on January 24, 2006, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all disputes and issues raised in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

- 1. The Internal Revenue Service notified the Division that Louisiana Interest, Inc. d/b/a Oz was ineligible for the required tax clearances.
- 2. On July 22, 2006, the Division issued a letter, via certified mail, instructing the Licensee to resolve the delinquencies within thirty (30) days. The letter was received on July 27, 2006. The thirty day period elapsed and no tax clearance was submitted to the Division.
- 3. On November 20, 2006, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Louisiana Interest, Inc. d/b/a Oz, VGL # 3601103654, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.
- 4. Johnny Chisholm, President of Louisiana Interest, Inc. d/b/a Oz, represents that all of the statements, responses, disclosures and representations provided in documents submitted to the Division bearing his signature, are true and correct to the best of his knowledge, information and belief, and represent a complete and accurate account of the requested information.
- 5. The Licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of LAC 42:XI.2405B(1)(b), in that it did not remain eligible for the required tax clearances for a portion of the existence of its license.
- 6. The Licensee is now eligible and has received tax clearance from the IRS.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Any and all information discovered throughout the course of this or any other investigation may be used in connection with any future violation(s), assessment of

penalty or in any future determination of the suitability of Johnny Chisholm and Louisiana Interest, Inc. d/b/a Oz.

- 2. Louisiana Interest, Inc. d/b/a Oz agrees to pay a civil penalty of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).
- 3. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Louisiana Interest, Inc. d/b/a Oz, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.
- 5. If approved, Louisiana Interest, Inc. d/b/a Oz must make payment of the civil penalty to the Division within ten (10) days of approval by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Failure to do so shall result in the immediate suspension of the license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

6. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
