### ORDER



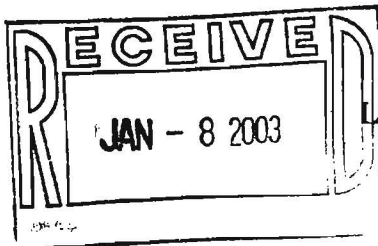

**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS  
AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**


**ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:**

1. The Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Video Gaming Division ("Division"), and
2. Beagan Corporation, – ("Beagan"), who respectfully represent the following:

**WHEREAS:**

1. Beagan failed to comply with the administrative requirements of a device owner in allowing employees that were not certified technicians to access the interior of enrolled and enabled gaming devices.
2. Beagan failed to secure device keys and failed to maintain accurate and current written maintenance logs for operating devices within an establishment.
3. Beagan engaged in activities with the willful intent to contravene the provisional requirements of the Division.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing Stipulations, the Division and Beagan hereby propose the following settlement:




1. Beagan admits that it was in violation of LAC 42:XI 2407(A)(4); LAC 42:XI 2407(A)(10); LAC 42:XI 2411(A)(10)(b); LAC 42:XI 2413(E)(1); LAC 42:XI 2413 (E)(1)(c); LAC 42:XI 2413(E)(2); LAC 42:XI 2417(C)(1)(b).
2. Consistent with the above-enumerated violations Beagan agrees to pay a civil penalty in the amount of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2500).
3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this violation in connection with any future violation.
4. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
5. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Beagan pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties.
6. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalty must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board.
7. The failure of Beagan to submit payment within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall constitute an additional violation of Louisiana gaming laws and regulations.
8. The Division and Beagan waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Beagan shall pay - civil penalty - of Twenty - Five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.00) due within fifteen days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.
