
**ORDER**



**COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter the "Division") and Demetrius Jackson, Permit No. P040039245 (hereinafter "Permittee") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division and Permittee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

**STIPULATIONS**

1. On January 11, 2011, the Division was notified, by the Internal Revenue Service, that the Permittee was not current in the filing and/or payment of his federal tax returns.
2. On January 11, 2011, the Division notified the Permittee, by certified mail, of his tax delinquency.

3. The Permittee stipulates that he received notice of his tax delinquency from the Division, on January 18, 2011.

4. The Permittee stipulates that he failed to remain current in the filing and/or payment of his federal taxes, as required by Louisiana Gaming Control Law.

5. The Division received the Permittee's federal tax clearance on August 5, 2011.

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Permittee shall pay TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$250.00) for the violation of La. R.S. 27:28(F), LAC 42:VII.2115(A), LAC 42:VII.2115(B)(1) and (2), LAC 42:XIII.2115(A), LAC 42:XIII.2115(B)(1) and (2) and LAC 42:XI.2131(A) and (B).

2. The Division hereby agrees to accept a TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLAR AND 00/100 (\$250.00) penalty for the Permittee's violation of La. R.S. 27:28(F), LAC 42:VII.2115(A), LAC 42:VII.2115(B)(1) and (2), LAC 42:XIII.2115(A), LAC 42:XIII.2115(B)(1) and (2) and LAC 42:XI.2131(A) and (B).

3. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.


4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Permittee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory,


but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

6. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Permittee must pay TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$250.00) within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the Permittee's non-key gaming employee permit, without the necessity of any further administrative action, until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.

Failure to do so shall result in the immediate suspension of the Permittee's non-key gaming employee permit without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.
