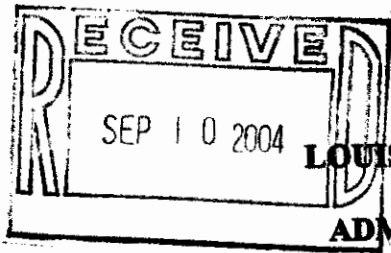

**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

1. the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, (hereinafter "Division"), and
2. T & D Ventures, LLC d/b/a Lucky Dollar Casino, No. 4701512880 (hereinafter "licensee"),

who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

1. On April 1, 2004, an agent of the Division observed a billboard advertisement for "The Lucky Dollar Casino", licensee, on La. 3125 eastbound. The advertisement failed to include the required toll-free telephone number for problem gambling.
2. The licensee is mandated by La. R.S. 27:27.3 to place the toll-free telephone number of the National Council on Problem Gambling (or other similar, Board-approved toll-free telephone number) in any advertisement of its gaming activities or gaming establishment.
3. Pursuant to its agent's observations, the Division issued Violation/Inspection Report #014726 to the licensee on April 2, 2004, citing violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3. Attendant to this Violation/Inspection Report, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to the licensee on or about June 7, 2004.
4. On March 13, 2003, the establishment was cited for the same violation and paid a civil penalty on September 22, 2003; this is the second violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3 for this licensee.
5. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on September 14, 2004 at 9:00 a.m. before the Honorable William H. Brown.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the licensee hereby propose the following settlement, that:


1. The licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3, in that it did not place the required problem gambling toll-free telephone number on the billboard advertisement that advertised the licensee's gaming establishment;
2. The licensee further acknowledges that this is a second violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3 attributable to this establishment;
3. In lieu of further administrative action against the licensee's video gaming license, the licensee shall pay a \$500.00 civil penalty;
4. The Division hereby agrees to accept the licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of Violation/Inspection Report No. 014726 and this Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;
5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
6. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
7. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and T & D Ventures, LLC. d/b/a Lucky Dollar Casino pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
8. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the licensee being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled until such time as the penalty is paid in full;
9. The Division and the licensee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.

4. payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; and
5. the failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the licensee being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled until such time as the penalty is paid in full.


