The Division and Licensee are desirous of compromising and settling all disputes between them relative to the referenced administrative proceeding. In connection therewith, the parties have entered into a compromise and settlement agreement which by its terms will become effective upon approval by the Administrative Hearing Office and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State

Police (hereinafter the "Division") and Louisiana Casino Cruises, Inc. d/b/a Hollywood Casino,

License No. R011700193 (hereinafter "Licensee") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Enforcement Division has issued a Notice of

Violation and Penalty to Licensee, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law;

and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Violation and Penalty are set for

hearing on May 23, 2007, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing

Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising

and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of

Violation and Penalty;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby

agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. Licensee stipulates that on or about December 27, 2003, Licensee notified the

Division of a pouch pay scam involving Licensee's employees. Subsequent investigation

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produced documentation supporting that employees created 245 fictitious jackpots on 94 days in 2003, resulting in the theft of at least \$229,000.00 from Licensee.

- 2. The employees systematically created fictitious jackpots by surreptitiously obtaining supervisor passwords and stealing the jackpot slips of some slot attendants. Once in the possession of stolen jackpot slips, the employees created fictitious jackpot request slips to match the stolen jackpot slips and presented both slips to a cashier for payment. As a result of these circumstances, the financial records of Licensee were neither accurate nor reliable. The Division alleged that these circumstances constitute a violation of the following regulations: LAC 42:XIII.2715(A)(2), LAC 42:XIII.2715(A)(3), LAC 42:XIII.2715(A)(4), LAC 42:XIII.2715(A)(5), LAC 42:XIII.2715(A)(7), LAC 42:XIII.2723(D)(1)(i), LAC 42:XIII.2723(D)(3), LAC 42:XIII.2723(T)(4), LAC 42:XIII.2723(T)(8), LAC 42:XIII.2723(T)(15).
- 3. Licensee further stipulates that the Louisiana Gaming Enforcement Division issued a NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND PENALTY ENF060033 SAR 05-2-19-122-1166.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee shall pay Two Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$2,500.00) Dollars for the violation of LAC 42:XIII.2715(A)(2).
- 2. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee shall pay Two Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$2,500.00) Dollars for the violation of LAC 42:XIII.2715(A)(3).
- 3. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee shall pay Two Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$2,500.00) Dollars for the violation of LAC 42:XIII.2715(A)(4).

- 4. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee shall pay Two Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$2,500.00) Dollars for the violation of LAC 42:XIII.2715(A)(7).
- 5. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee shall pay One Hundred Thousand and No/100 (\$100,000.00) Dollars for the violation of LAC 42:XIII.2723(D)(1)(i).
- 6. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee shall pay Two Thousand and No/100 (\$2,000.00) Dollars for the violation of LAC 42:XIII.2723(D)(4).
- 7. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee shall pay One Hundred Thousand and No/100 (\$100,000.00) Dollars for the violation of LAC 42:XIII.2723(T)(2).
- 8. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee shall pay Eight Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$8,500.00) Dollars for the violation of LAC 42:XIII.2723(T)(8).
- 9. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee shall pay Two Thousand and No/100 (\$2,000.00) Dollars for the violation of LAC 42:XIII.2723(T)(13).
- 10. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee shall pay Two Thousand and No/100 (\$2,000.00) Dollars for the violation of LAC 42:XIII.2723(T)(15).
- 11. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

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12. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement

between the Division and Licensee, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and

supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the

parties.

13. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the

Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this

proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory,

but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether

to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

14. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee must pay the

aggregate of items one through 10 above, which amounts to Two Hundred Twenty-Four

Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$224,500.00) Dollars within fifteen (15) calendar days of

such approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the

gaming license until paid in full, without the necessity of any further administrative action.

15. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted

violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty, and in

connection with any future assessments of the Licensee's suitability.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms

and conditions hereof.
