

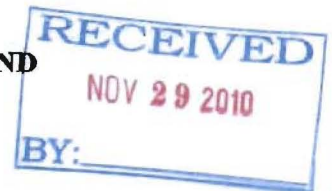



**COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Grand Palais Riverboat, Inc. d/b/a Isle of Capri (hereinafter "Isle of Capri") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Isle of Capri alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division and Isle of Capri are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

**STIPULATIONS**

1. On or about May 17, 2010, an agent of State Police was notified by the Compliance Officer of Isle of Capri that they had exceeded the \$200,000.00 per calendar year threshold of payments to Talen's Marine and Fuel, a non-gaming supplier of fuel to Isle of Capri.

2. The Compliance Officer further stated that the Purchasing Manager had discovered the violation on May 13, 2010.

3. Isle of Capri had paid Talen's Marine and Fuel approximately \$300,097.84 and there was an outstanding balance of \$32,169.83 still owed to Talen's Marine and Fuel by Isle of Capri, for a grand total of \$332,267.67.

4. It was further discovered that the non-gaming supplier's permit of Talen's Marine and Fuel had expired on July 11, 2007.

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. In lieu of Administrative Action of its Gaming License, Isle of Capri will pay a civil penalty of TWELVE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$12,000.00) DOLLARS.

2. The Division hereby agrees to accept Isle of Capri's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.

3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of Isle of Capri's suitability.

4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Isle of Capri, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.


6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory,

but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits. Failure to pay the penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, and to comply with each term and condition listed herein, shall result in the immediate suspension of Isle of Capri's license without the necessity of further administrative action, until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.



ORDER

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Compromise and Settlement Agreement attached to the parties' Joint Motion for Approval of Compromise and Settlement Agreement be, and the same is hereby, APPROVED; that Grand Palais Riverboat, Inc. d/b/a Isle of Capri must pay Twelve Thousand and No/100 (\$12,000.00) Dollars to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Failure to do so shall result in the immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.
