NOW COMES the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter the "Division") and Rhett Guidry d/b/a Paradise II, License No. 270411165 (hereinafter "Licensee"), who file this Joint Motion for Approval of Compromise and Settlement Agreement, and in support thereof would respectively show unto the Hearing Officer as follows:

The Division and Licensee are desirous of compromising and settling all disputes between them relative to the referenced administrative proceeding. In connection therewith, the parties have entered into a compromise and settlement agreement which by its terms will become effective upon approval by the Administrative Hearing Office and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State

Police (hereinafter the "Division") and Rhett Guidry d/b/a Paradise II, License No. 270411165

(hereinafter "Licensee") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of

Recommendation of Revocation, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law;

and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Revocation, are

set for hearing on February 9, 2011, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative

Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising

and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of

Recommendation of Revocation;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby

agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. The Licensee stipulates that it failed to submit its Annual Licensee Form, state

sales tax clearance, local sales tax clearance, record update form, copy of its current ATC permit

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and the \$200.00 annual license fee by August 31, 2010 in violation of La. R.S. 27:311(K)(4)(a) and (d), LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(a) and (b), and LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(i).

2. The Division stipulates that it did not receive the licensee's annual licensee form, state sales tax clearance, local sales tax clearance, record update form, copy of its current ATC permit and the \$200.00 annual license fee until January 7, 2011.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Licensee shall pay One Thousand and No/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars for the violation of La. R.S. 27:311(K)(4)(a) and (d), LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(a) and (b), and LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(i).
- 2. The Division hereby agrees to accept a One Thousand and No/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollar penalty for the Licensee's violation of La. R.S. 27:311(K)(4)(a) and (d), LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(a) and (b), and LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(i).
- 3. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Licensee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

6. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee must pay One Thousand and No/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
