DECISION OF THE
LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

IN RE: CIRO F. MUSSLE NO. P040033017

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board ("Board") on appeal by Ciro

F. Mussle, P0400333017, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated June 30, 2014, in which his

permit was revoked. The Hearing Officer found that Mr. Mussle is unsuitable for and

disqualified from possessing a gaming employee permit. The basis of the Hearing Officer's

finding was a pending charge for theft and evidence of the crime including Mr. Mussle's

admission to the theft while at the casino where he was employed.

Mr. Mussle alleges that his case was dismissed and states that he never admitted to theft.

Attached to his appeal is a copy of a letter from the 19th Judicial District DA stating that Mr.

Mussle had completed the pre-trial intervention program and the case would be dismissed. The

document is not part of the record and cannot be considered.

We will remand this matter to the Hearing Officer. He will consider any new evidence

and render a decision accordingly. Either party may then appeal.

ORDER

This matter having been considered by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board in open meeting of August 21, 2014:

IT IS ORDERED THAT this matter be REMANDED for the purpose and reasons set forth in this decision.
