22	MR. TYLER: Board Members, Assistant
23	Attorney General Michael Tyler, and
24	today I'm joined by John Francic with
25	the American Bureau of Shipping
	11
1	Consultants or ABSC. We come before you
2	in the matter of the issuance of a
3	Certificate of Compliance to
4	Margaritaville Casino. If you remember,
5	in May of 2013, the Board was advised
6	that ABSC would begin its inspection
7	process for the issuance of a
8	Certificate of Compliance to
9	Margaritaville. This was to have
10	commenced on May 22nd, 2013.
11	For more on the inspection process
12	and its findings, I now turn this

13	presentation over to John Francic.
14	MR. FRANCIC: Good morning, Board
15	Members. John Francic with ABS
16	Consulting. I'm here to report the
17	certification for Margaritaville Casino.
18	The final phase of the inspection
19	process began on May 22nd and was
20	completed on June 10th. It was a very
21	busy two-and-a-half weeks, but the
22	contractor and Margaritaville personnel
23	came through and all testing was
24	satisfactory and complete.
25	We tested the landside generator,
	12
1	and the casino came online powering all
2	operational equipment as required. The
3	walk-through and fire drill was
4	satisfied with the results but continued
5	trying to get their crew to improve the
6	performance of the teams.
7	The life safety item listed on the
8	report are about 80 percent complete as
9	of June 11th. Everything has, you know,
10	been found in good order, and we really
11	have no issues with Margaritaville
12	Casino.
13	MR. TYLER: We now present these
14	findings to this Honorable Board and
15	request that upon the Board accepting

16	the report submitted by ABSC, that the
17	Board will move for Margaritaville
18	Casino to receive a Certificate of
19	Compliance with an approval date of
20	June 12th, 2013. The certificate we're
21	requesting shall expire within 90 days
22	of issuance or three months of its
23	issuance or upon completion of all
24	outstanding inspection items that you
25	should have a list there of, whichever
	13
1	occurs first. Once these inspection
2	items are completed, Margaritaville
3	Casino will receive its final
4	Certificate of Compliance but the
5	anniversary date of that certificate
6	will be June 12th.
7	MADAM CHAIRWOMAN: Are there any

9	MR. STIPE: Just real quick. The
10	facility is not 100 percent completed;
11	is that correct?
12	MR. FRANCIC: Yes. There's some
