COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter the "Division") and Shackles, Inc. d/b/a Zone 24 Bar & Liquor., License No. 0106114736 (hereinafter "Licensee") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHIREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action, alleging certain violations of Louisians Caming Control Law and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative

Action are set for hearing on February 26, 2007, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board

Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and sertling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. The Licensee submitted the Annual Licensee Form and fee prior to July 1, 2006, but submitted the required tax clearance certificates on January 10, 2007, in violation of L.A.C. 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(b).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Cortrol Board, the Licensee shall pay Two Hundred Fifty dollars and No/100 (\$250.00) Dollars for the violation of L.A.C 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(b).
- 2. The Division hereby agrees to accept the Licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty, and in connection with any future assessment of the Licensee's suitability
- 4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the lay's of the State of Louisiana.
- 5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Licensee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 6. This Compromise and Scalement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed sett ement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the ments.

7. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Licensee must pay two

hundred fift, dollars and No/100 (\$250.00) Dollars within fifteen (15) calendar days of such

approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the gaming

license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is

paid in full.

and conditions hereof.
