COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "the Division") and JCM American Corporation, P066501594/P076501597, do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to JCM American Corporation, which notice alleges certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on August 21, 2006, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all disputes and issues raised in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. Pursuant to La. R.S. 27:28B.4, LAC 42.VII.2121.A.8, LAC 42.VII.2901.C.1.i, LAC 42.IX.2107.A.9, LAC 42.IX.2127.D, LAC 42.XIII.2121.A.8, and LAC 42.XIII.2901.C.1.i, JCM American Corporation is required to submit applications and information, as requested by the Division, within the prescribed time periods.



- 2. JCM American Corporation did not timely submit the applications of Dante Olgado and Mark Henderson and failed to timely respond to the Division's request for information.
- 3. On June 30, 2006, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to JCM American Corporation, P066501594/ P076501597, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this violation in connection with any future violations.
- 2. A subsequent failure to timely submit applications or respond to information requests from the Division, will result, at a minimum, in an enhanced civil penalty.
- 3. Any and all information discovered throughout the course of this or any other investigation may be used in any future determination of the suitability of JCM American Corporation.
- 4. JCM American Corporation agrees to pay a civil penalty of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00).
- 5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and JCM American Corporation, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood

that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

- 7. If approved, JCM American Corporation must make payment of the civil penalty and delinquency fee to the Division within ten (10) days of approval by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Failure to do so shall result in the immediate suspension of the license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.
- 8. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement, understand it, and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
