COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State

Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Coulthard's, Inc. d/b/a Animal House, License No.

2600112267 (hereinafter, "Licensee") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana General Gaming Division has issued a Notice of

Recommendation of Administrative Action, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming

Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Revocation and

Notice of Recommendation of Finding of Unsuitability are set for hearing on December 3, 2007,

before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising

and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of

Recommendation of Revocation and Notice of Recommendation of Finding of Unsuitability;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby

agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

Licensee stipulates that on February 27, 2007, Ronald B. Coulthard, the president 1.

and 100% owner of Licensee's establishment, was arrested by the City of Gretna Police

Department for aggravated assault with a firearm in violation of La. R.S. 14:37.4, simple criminal damage to property under \$500.00 in violation of La. R.S. 14:56, and illegal carrying of a weapon in violation of La. R.S. 14:95. On March 21, 2007, Jefferson Parish District Attorney's Office refused the simple criminal damage to property under \$500.00 in violation of La. R.S. 14:56 and illegal carrying of a weapon in violation of La. R.S. 14:95. However, the felony chares of simple criminal damage to property over \$500.00 in violation of La. R.S. 14:56 and aggravated assault with a firearm in violation of La. R.S. 14:37.4 were accepted. On October 12, 2007, Ronald B. Coulthard pled guilty to two misdemeanor charges, illegal carrying of a weapon in violation of La. R.S. 14:95 and simple criminal damage to property under \$500.00 in violation of La. R.S. 14:56.

2. Licensee further stipulates that Ronald B. Coulthard failed to notify the Division within fifteen (15) days of the arrest, which violates LAC 42:XI.2417(A)(2), LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(3) and LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(b).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee shall pay One Thousand and No/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars for the violation of LAC 42:XI.2417(A)(2), LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(3) and LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(b).
- 2. The Division hereby agrees to a One Thousand and No/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollar fine for the Licensee's violation of LAC 42:XI.2417(A)(2), LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(3) and LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(b).
- 3. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Licensee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and

supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the

parties.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the

Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this

proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory,

but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether

to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

6. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee must pay One

Thousand and No/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval.

Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate revocation of the gaming license

without the necessity of any further administrative action.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms

and conditions hereof.
