## DECISION OF THE LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

IN RE: ANGELLA LEBLANC NO. V000020148

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by Angella LeBlanc, Application No. V000020148, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated July 27, 2015, wherein the denial of Ms. LeBlanc's video draw poker employee permit application by the Gaming Enforcement Division of the Louisiana State Police ("the Division") was affirmed.

The Hearing Officer found that Ms. LeBlanc failed to accurately and completely answer portions of the application regarding her criminal history. He found that Ms. LeBlanc failed to prove her suitability as required by La. R.S. 27:427 and La. R.S. 27:447.

We agree with the Hearing Officer's decision that the denial be affirmed because Ms. LeBlanc did not meet her burden of proving her suitability. We find that Ms. LeBlanc is not likely to conduct business as authorized by gaming law and she lacks the honesty required by statute.

## **ORDER**

This matter having been considered by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board in open meeting of September 17, 2015:

IT IS ORDERED THAT the Hearing Officer's decision is AFFIRMED.
