This matter came before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board (the "Board") on appeal by Mardi Gras Bar & Grill, LLC d/b/a Mardi Gras Bar & Grill, No. 3601218527, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated April 9, 2026, denying Mardi Gras Bar & Grill, LLC d/b/a Mardi Gras Bar & Grill's original application for a Type 2 video draw poker gaming license, and finding Demitri A. Williams unsuitable to participate in the Louisiana video gaming industry.

Mr. David Belfield, III, attorney for Mardi Gras Bar & Grill, LLC d/b/a Mardi Gras Bar & Grill, requested that this matter be reset due to his illness and inability to appear at the Board meeting. The Louisiana State Police, Gaming Enforcement Division was not opposed to the matter being continued and reset to the August monthly Board meeting.
