JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

- 1. The Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Video Gaming Division (hereinafter "Division"), and
- 2. YTT Bar and Restaurant d/b/a YTT Bar and Restaurant, License No. 2609114034 (hereinafter "Licensee"),

who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

- 1. On or about March 1, 2004, the Division mailed Licensee the Annual Form which is required to be submitted with all appropriate fees and current tax clearance certificates on or before July 1, 2004. However, the Licensee failed to submit its Annual Form, annual fees and appropriate tax clearance certificates timely. The Division did not receive these filings until on or about September 3, 2004;
- 2. The Licensee is mandated by La. R.S. 27:311(K)(4) and LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4) to submit payment by July first of each year the annual fees required.
- 3. The Licensee is further mandated by LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4) to submit preof of current tax filings and payments, including tax clearance certificates from the state and all appropriate local taxing authorities to the division along with the annual fee no later than July 1st of each year,

- 4. On or about October 14, 2004, the Division issued Violation/Inspection Report No. 15016, and on or about January 31, 2005, the Division issued a Supplemental Violation/Inspection Report (hereinafter, the Violation/Inspection Report and the Supplemental Violation/Inspection Report will collectively be referred to as the "Violation/Inspection Report"). The Violation/Inspection Report cited violations of La. R.S. 27:311(K)(4) and LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4). Attendant to the Violation/Inspection Report, the Louisians Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to the Licensee on or about July 20, 2005.
- 5. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on December 5, 2005, at 9:30 a.m. before the Honorable Joseph E. Anzalone, Jr.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the Licensee hereby propose to settle this matter pursuant to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The Licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:311(K)(4) and LAC 42:X1.2405(B)(4) in that it did not submit the Annual form, fees, and proof of current tax filings from the appropriate local taxing authorities to the Division until on or about September 3, 2004.
- 2. In consideration of the previous and aforementioned settlement of Violation/Inspection Report No. 15016 and in lieu of further administrative action against the Licensee's video gaming license, the Licensee shall pay a \$500.00 civil penalty;
- 3. The Division hereby agrees to accept the Licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of Violation/Inspection Report No. 15016 and this Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;
- 4. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;

5. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;

6. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Licensee, YTT Bar & Restaurant and the Division pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;

7. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be remanded to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing. If approved by the Board, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board. The failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the immediate suspension of the video gaming license of the Licensee and its garring devices being disabled until such a time as the penalty is paid in full.

Considering the foregoing Joint Motion For Entry of Stipulations and Approval of Proposed Settlement, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that such proposed settlement be approved, to wit:

- 1. The Licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:311(K)(4) and LAC 42:XJ.2405(B)(4) in that it did not submit its Annual form, fee and proof of current tax filings from the appropriate local taxing authorities to the Division until on or about September 3, 2004, which was two months past the duc date of July 1, 2004, for this current year;
- The Licensee shall pay a \$500.00 civil penalty;
- 3. Payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; and
- 4. The failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in immediate suspension of the video gaming license of the Licensee and its gaming devices being disabled until the penalty is paid in full.
