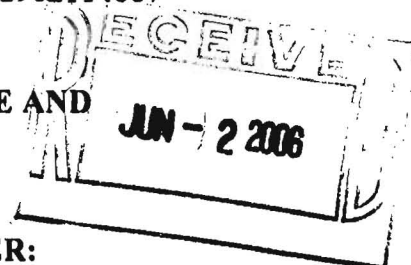

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING OFFICER:





COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "the Division") and Daiquiris Hut, LLC d/b/a Daiquiris Hut (hereinafter "Daiquiris Hut") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, on December 19, 2005, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Daiquiris Hut alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on June 1, 2006, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Daiquiris Hut are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:



STIPULATIONS

1. On May 3, 2005, Amar N. Ali purchased 100% of the shares/units of Daiquiris Hut, LLC d/b/a Daiquiris Hut.
2. The previous owners of Daiquiris Hut, LLC were David Dufrene, a 50% owner, and Kim Dufrene, a 50% owner.
3. At the time that Amar N. Ali purchased Daiquiris Hut, LLC, the limited liability company faced administrative action for unresolved violations of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(1)(b) and LAC 42:XI. 2417(B)(4).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Daiquiris Hut will pay a civil penalty of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00).
2. The Division hereby agrees to accept Daiquiris Hut's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action issued on December 19, 2005.
3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation, assessment of penalty or the ongoing suitability of Daiquiris Hut.
4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Daiquiris Hut, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits. Failure to pay the penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement shall result in the immediate suspension of Daiquiris Hut's video gaming license.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
