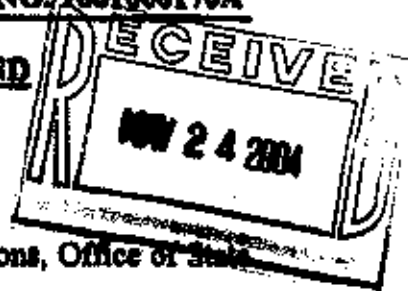

JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND  
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT



ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

1. the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "Division"), and
2. Darrell Derouen d/b/a Darrell's Video, License No. 1001600170,

who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

1. On March 10, 2001, Darrell Derouen (sole proprietor of Darrell's Video) was arrested by the Marshall County, Oklahoma, Sheriff's Office for Driving Under the Influence, Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance with the Intent to Distribute, and Possession of a Firearm During the Commission of a Felony;
2. On February 19, 2002, Mr. Derouen appeared in the 20<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court regarding these charges. The charge of Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance with the Intent to Distribute was dismissed by the District Attorney's Office. However, Mr. Derouen pled *nolo contendere* to the charge of Driving Under the Influence (a misdemeanor) and to Possession of a Firearm During the Commission of a Felony (a felony);
3. Mr. Derouen failed to disclose his arrest or his subsequent pleas of *nolo contendere* to the Division, neither at the time they occurred nor in subsequent correspondence to the Division;
4. Pursuant to La. R.S. 27:310(A)(1), Mr. Derouen is statutorily precluded from licensing by his felony plea for Possession of a Firearm During the Commission of a Felony until on or about February 19, 2016;
5. Based on the failure to disclose his criminal activity to the Division and on La. R.S. 27:310(A)(1), Mr. Derouen was issued a Notice of Recommendation of Revocation by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on August 25, 2003; and

6. This matter is scheduled for hearing on May 18, 2004 at 9:00 a.m. before the Honorable William H. Brown,


**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and Darrell Derouen hereby propose the following settlement, that:

1. Mr. Derouen acknowledges that he violated LAC 42:XI.2417(B) in that he failed to disclose the above-referenced criminal activity to the Division;
2. In lieu of revocation of his Type 6 license, Mr. Derouen shall surrender his license to the Division within ten (10) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, if not sooner;
3. Mr. Derouen hereby agrees that he shall not participate in the video gaming industry in Louisiana in any capacity which would require him to be found suitable by the Division for a period of five (5) years from the date of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board;
4. The Division hereby agrees to accept Mr. Derouen's surrender of his license and his agreement to the above preclusionary period in full and final settlement of this Notice of Recommendation of Revocation;
5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
6. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
7. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Darrell Derouen pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
8. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, Mr. Derouen must surrender his Type 6 license to the Division within ten (10) days of approval - failure to do so shall result in the revocation of Mr. Derouen's Type 6 video gaming license; and
9. The Division and the licensee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.



4. Failure to surrender his Type 6 video gaming license to the Division within ten (10) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the revocation of that Type 6 license.
