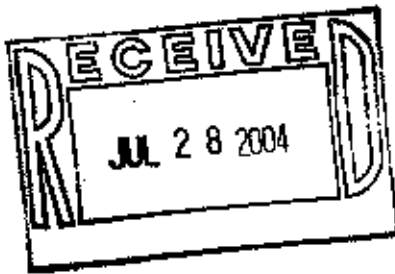

**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND  
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**

**ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:**

1. the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Video Gaming Division (hereinafter "Division"), and
2. St. Rose Travel Center, LLC d/b/a, St. Rose Travel Center, VGL. No. 4500512378 (hereinafter "licensee"),

who respectfully represent the following:

**WHEREAS:**

1. On or about February 1, 2004, a printed advertisement for The Rose Casino was observed in the February 1, 2004 issue of *The Times Picayune* newspaper by a private citizen and forwarded to the Division. This advertisement, which invited the public to "join the fun at The Rose Casino" offered video poker and failed to include the required toll-free telephone number for problem gambling;
2. The licensee is mandated by La. R.S. 27:27.3 to place the toll-free telephone number of the National Council on Problem Gambling (or other similar, Board-approved toll-free telephone number) in any advertisement of its gaming activities or gaming establishment;
3. On March 4, 2004, a Division agent traveled to The St. Rose Travel Center to issue a citation for violation of La. R. S. 27:27.3 to the licensee. While in the process of issuing Violation/Inspection Report #14445, the agent observed that the licensee's security guard was not wearing a uniform in violation of LAC 42:XI 2415 (B)(1) and added that violation to Report #14445. Attendant to Violation/Inspection Report #14445, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to the licensee on or about May 27, 2004;

4. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on July 28, 2004 at 9:00 a.m. before the Honorable William H. Brown;


**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the licensee hereby propose the following settlement, that:

1. The licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3, in that it did not place the required problem gambling toll-free telephone number on its advertisement observed on February 1, 2004 and LAC 42:XI. 2415 (B)(1) in that its security guard was not in uniform on March 4, 2004;
2. In lieu of further administrative action against the licensee's video gaming license, the licensee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;
3. The Division hereby agrees to accept the licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of Violation/Inspection Report No. 14445 and this Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;
4. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
5. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
6. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and St. Rose Travel Center, LLC d/b/a St. Rose Travel Center, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
7. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the licensee being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled until such time as the penalty is paid in full; and
8. The Division and the licensee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.



ORDER

Considering the foregoing Joint Motion for Entry of Stipulations and Approval of Proposed Settlement, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that such proposed settlement be approved, to wit:

1. the licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3, in that it did not include the required problem gambling toll-free telephone number in the magazine advertisement that advertised its gaming establishment and LAC 42:XI.2415(B)(1) in that its security guard was not in uniform on March 4, 2004;
2. the licensee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty for violation of LAC 42:XI.2415(B)(1) and a \$500.00 civil penalty for violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3 for a total penalty of \$750.00;
3. payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; and
4. the failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the licensee being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled until such time as the penalty is paid in full.


