**DECISION OF THE** LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

> IN RE: TACO TICO OF NEW ORLEANS, INC. D/B/A TACO TICO NO. 2600212036

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by Taco Tico of New Orleans, Inc. d/b/a Taco Tico, License No. 2600212036, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated June 27, 2013, in which he revoked Taco Tico's video gaming license because Taco Tico was delinquent in the filing or payment of federal taxes.

The licensee in its appeal alleges that it is now has a tax clearance from the IRS. The tax clearance is not part of the record and cannot be considered.

The licensee also argues that it did not receive notifications from the Division that were sent by certified mail because it refused to claim the letters at the post office. The licensee did receive the notifications which were sent to the proper address. The licensee chose not to claim the notifications.

We will remand this matter to the Hearing Officer for the introduction of evidence supporting this allegation. He will then consider any new evidence and render a decision accordingly which may include revocation or the imposition of a civil penalty for failure of the license to remain current in the payment of its federal taxes. Either party may then appeal.
