JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPLUALTION AND APPROVAL OF
PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

On Joint Motion of:

- (i) the State of Louisiana, Office of State Police, Video Gaming Division (“Division”), and
- (ii) Opelousas 190 Truck Stop, L.L.C. (“the licensee”),

who enter the following Stipulations into the record:

1.

On August 22, 2001, August 29,2001, September 5, 2001, September 12, 2001, September 19, 2001, September 26, 2001, October 3, 2001, November 28, 2001, December 12, 2001, December 19, 2001, May 12, 2002, May 19, 2002, May 23, 2002, June 2, 2002, June 9, 2002, June 16, 2002, June 23, 2002 ,June 30, 2002, and July 7, 2020, an advertisement for the licensee appeared in the Daily World Newspaper. These advertisements did not contain the required toll-free number for compulsive gambling.

2.

On August 13, 2002, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Violation and Hearing based upon the alleged violation of La. 27:27.3.

La. R.S. 27:3 reads:

In any advertisement of gaming activities or of a gaming establishment that is offered to the general public in print by any licensee or the casino gaming operator operated pursuant to the provisions of this Title, the toll-free telephone number of the National Council on Problem Gambling or a similar toll-free number approved by the board shall be placed on such advertisement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the forgoing Stipulations, the Division and licensee hereby propose the following settlement:


- (1) The licensee does admit to the violation of La. R.S. 27:3.
- (2) The licensee will pay a civil penalty of TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00).
- (3) The Division hereby agrees to accept the licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of this matter.
- (4) The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation.
- (5) This Stipulation and Settlement is to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- (6) This Stipulation and Settlement constitute the entire agreement between the Division and the licensee pertaining to the subject matter contained, herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties.
- (7) This Stipulation and Settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if these proposed Stipulations and Settlement are approved by the Hearing


Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer ; if approved, payment of the above penalty must be submitted within fifteen (15) days of this approval to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board

(8) Division and the licensee waive their rights to appeal this Stipulation and Settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

CONSIDERING the foregoing Joint Motion and Stipulations,




