**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATION AND APPROVAL OF  
PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**

On Joint Motion of:

- (i) the State of Louisiana, Office of State Police, Casino Gaming Division ("Division"), and
  - (ii) Jazz Casino Company, L.L.C. d/b/a Harrah's New Orleans,
- who enter the following Stipulations into the record:

1.

On October 14, 2002, Division agents initiated an investigation to determine whether Harrah's New Orleans Casino was complying with gaming regulations and the licensee's own internal controls regarding required sensitive key log documentation.

2.

The investigation revealed that numerous entries documented in the Customer Safety Log regarding the issuance and return of sensitive keys during the period from January 1, 2002, through November 1, 2002 were incomplete.

~~NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the forgoing Stipulations, the~~  
Division and Harrah's New Orleans Casino hereby propose the following settlement:


- (1) Harrah's New Orleans does admit to eight violations of LAC 42:IX.2715(A)(11).
- (2) Harrah's New Orleans will pay a civil penalty of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80, 000).
- (3) The Division hereby agrees to accept Harrah's New Orleans payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of CGD 020523.
- (4) This Stipulation and Settlement is to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- (5) This Stipulation and Settlement constitute the entire agreement between the Division and Harrah's New Orleans pertaining to the subject matter contained, herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties.
- (6) This Stipulation and Settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly


understood that if these proposed Stipulations and Settlement are approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, payment of the above penalty must be submitted within fifteen (15) days of this approval to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

(7) Division and Harrah's New Orleans waive their rights to appeal this Stipulation and Settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

ORDER


CONSIDERING the foregoing Joint Motion and Stipulations,


