**DECISION OF THE

**IN RE: JOACHIMA M. BUDWINE  
P040064392**

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by Joachima M. Budwine, P040064392, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated October 31, 2024, wherein her Non-Key Gaming Employee Permit was revoked and she was found unsuitable to participate in the Louisiana gaming industry. The basis of the disqualification was for a pending criminal charge and unsuitable conduct.

The Permittee now alleges that the criminal charge is no longer pending against her. Any new evidence is not part of the record and cannot be considered.

The Board remands this matter to the Hearing Officer for the introduction of evidence regarding this allegation. The Hearing Officer will consider all evidence and render a decision accordingly. Either party may then appeal.

**ORDER**


This matter having been considered by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board in open meeting of February 20, 2025:
