

COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Catfish Queen Partnership in Commendam d/b/a Belle of Baton Rouge Casino (hereinafter "Belle of Baton Rouge") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Belle of Baton Rouge alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office on April 27, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Belle of Baton Rouge are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. An investigation conducted by Louisiana State Police revealed that between December 23, 2009, and January 5, 2010, some of the vessel shifts for the Belle of Baton Rouge (N2286394.1)

vessel, Argosy III, were manned by Captains who did not possess valid non-key gaming employee permits.

- 2. On December 23, 2009, a State Police Lieutenant met with the Human Resource Director and the Casino Administrator of the Belle of Baton Rouge, to discuss whether a non-permitted Captain could work until other arrangements could be made given that one of the Captains of the Belle of Baton Rouge had resigned on December 23, 2009 and the other two Captains of the Belle of Baton Rouge could not be located or otherwise refused to work over the Christmas holidays. The State Police Lieutenant stated that each Captain must possess a valid non-key gaming employee permit.
- 3. On December 28, 2009, the Lieutenant had a telephone conference with the Director of Compliance of the Belle of Baton Rouge, who stated that he was unaware of the situation, but would find out more information.
- 4. On January 5, 2010, the Lieutenant received notice from the Director of Compliance indicating that the boat currently had four (4) Captains on staff, and only two (2) of the four (4) had non-key gaming employee permits and that two (2) temporary Captains who had to be brought in to work over the holidays did not possess non-key gaming employee permits. It ultimately was determined that a total of four (4) Captains worked on the vessel at various times between December 23, 2009 and January 5, 2010 who did not possess non-key gaming employee permits.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. In lieu of Administrative Action of its Gaming License, Belle of Baton Rouge will pay a civil penalty of THIRTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$30,000.00) DOLLARS.
- 2. The Division hereby agrees to accept Belle of Baton Rouge's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.

The Division reserves the right to take into consideration the foregoing

stipulations and terms and conditions in connection with any future investigation, violation or

assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of Belle of Baton Rouge's

suitability.

3.

4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted

under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement

between the Division and Belle of Baton Rouge, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein

and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of

the parties.

5.

6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the

Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this

proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory,

but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether

to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

Failure to pay the penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana

Gaming Control Board, and to comply with each term and condition listed herein, shall result in

the immediate suspension of Belle of Baton Rouge's license without the necessity of further

administrative action, until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms

and conditions hereof.
