COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of

State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and TWTB, Inc. d/b/a Lucy's, License No.

3601207734 (hereinafter, "Licensee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of

Recommendation of Denial of Application for Type 2 Video Gaming License, alleging

certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Denial of Renewal

Application, are set for hearing February 20, 2008, before the Louisiana Gaming Control

Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Permittee are desirous of fully and finally

compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with

the said Notice of Recommendation of Denial of Renewal Application;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do

hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

- 1. The applicant failed to timely submit fingerprint cards in violation of LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(i).
- 2. The applicant failed to timely submit the Resolution of the Minutes of Meeting showing the removal of Ross Haefer in 1995 and Mark Britton in 1998 in violation of LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(i).
- 3. The applicant also failed to timely notify the Division of the changes referenced in the previous lines in violation of LAC 42:XI.2411(A)(9).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Permittee shall pay a civil penalty of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the violation of LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(i) and LAC 42:XI.2411(A)(9). The Division hereby agrees to accept the payment of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Denial of Renewal Application.
- The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted 2. violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty, and in connection with any future assessments of the Licensee's sultability.
- 3. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Permittee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

- 5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.
- 6. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Licensee must pay Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
