DECISION OF THE LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

IN RE: KYRIA DAVIS NO. P040062476

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by Kyria Davis,

Permit No. P040062476, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated January 9, 2015, in which

her non-key gaming employee permit was revoked. At the time of the hearing, Ms. Davis had

pending charges for theft and possession of marijuana.

In her appeal, Ms. Davis alleges that she is in a pre-trial diversion program and with

successful completion of the program; the charges will no longer be on her record. The Division

argues that we cannot consider the statements in Ms. Davis' appeal regarding the pre-trial

diversion program but asks that we consider a statement in the same letter regarding an

admission by Ms. Davis.

We cannot consider evidence which is not part of the record with the Hearing Office.

The Hearing Officer based his decision on the pending charges. We will remand this

matter to the Hearing Officer for the introduction of evidence regarding the pre-trial diversion

program and other relevant evidence regarding pending charges. If there are no longer any

pending charges and if Ms. Davis has not pled guilty, the Hearing Officer could decide to allow

Ms. Davis to keep her permit.

He will consider any new evidence and render a decision accordingly. Either party may then appeal.
