STIPULATION AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Stipulation and Settlement Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into by:

- (i) the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police. Casino Gaming Division (the "Division") acting herein for and on behalf of themselves and for the Louisiana Gaming Control Board (the "State"); and
- (ii) Louisiana Casino Cruises, Inc., d/b/a Casino Rouge acting herein on its own behalf and on behalf of Penn National Gaming, Inc., its parent and all of the subsidiaries of Penn National Gaming, Inc. ("Casino Rouge").

Stipulations:

Whereas, a Notice of Violation and Penalty was issued by the Division to Casino Rouge on August 27, 2002 alleging that Casino Rouge violated several casino gaming regulations relating to cage, land vault and credit procedures during the time frame beginning May 8, 2001 and ending December 14, 2001;

And Whereas, Casino Rouge desires to settle and agree to certain of the allegations contained in the Notice of Violation.

And now, therefore, in consideration of the foregoing Stipulations, the Division and Casino Rouge hereby propose and agree to the following Settlement:

- 1. Casino Rouge admits to the following violations and agrees to pay the fines set opposite each violation, as follows:
 - 1. Two (2) Violations of LAC 42:XIII.4313(A) for a total fine of \$10,000.00;
 - 2. One (1) Violation of LAC 42:XIII 2715(A)(12)(b) for a total fine of \$10,000.00;

One (1) Violation of LAC 42:XIII 2715(A)(1) for a total fine of \$2,500.00;
 One (1) Violation of LAC 42:XIII 2729(B) for a total fine of \$5,000.00;
 Three (3) Violations of LAC 42:XIII 2729(C) for a total fine of \$15,000.00;
 One (1) Violation of LAC 42:XIII 2729(D) for a total fine of \$5,000.00;
 One (1) Violation of LAC 42:XIII 2715(A)(7) for a total fine of \$2,500.00;

- 2. Subject to the approval of the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, in consideration of the foregoing Stipulations and Settlement proposal, the Division agrees to accept a payment from Casino Rouge of \$50,000 in full and final settlement of all claims related to or arising from the alleged violations and the matters that are the subject of the Notice of Violation CGD: 020200. The Division, however, reserves its right to take this violation into consideration during the prospective period for purposes of assessing future violations of the same regulations referred to in Paragraph one above.
- 3. It is expressly understood that this proposed Agreement, if approved by the Hearing Officer is expressly conditioned upon approval by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, but will become a binding agreement among the parties upon such approval. The parties hereby consent to this procedure.
- 4. If approved by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the parties hereto waive their rights to appeal this Stipulation and Settlement Agreement.

5. This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Louisiana.
