**TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING OFFICER:**


NOW COMES the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and K & J, Inc. d/b/a J & K Bar, License No. 3601100228 (hereinafter, "Licensee"), who file this Joint Motion for Approval of Compromise and Settlement Agreement, and in support thereof would respectively show unto the Hearing Officer as follows:

The Division and Licensee are desirous of compromising and settling all disputes between them relative to the referenced administrative proceeding. **COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and K & J, Inc. d/b/a J & K Bar, License No. 3601100228 (hereinafter, "Licensee") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on January 23, 2008, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

**STIPULATIONS**

1. Licensee acknowledges that **La. R.S 27:310(D) and L.A.C. 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(i)** requires Licensee to respond to the Division within a timely fashion.

2. Licensee further acknowledges that on January 6, 2007, Deborah L. Dugas, officer, director and 50% owner of the Licensee, died. The Division was not notified until June 1, 2007, and the notification was received from the device operator for the licensed establishment rather than the Licensee.

3. On or about June 11, 2007, the Division sent a certified letter to Licensee requesting that certain succession documentation and information be submitted to the Division within ten (10) days of receipt of the letter.

4. On June 22, 2007, John Dugas, officer, director, owner of the remaining 50% interest in the Licensee, contacted the Division and stated that he would contact his attorney regarding the Division's request for succession documents.

5. On or about July 17, 2007, the Division sent a certified letter to Licensee requesting the same succession documentation and information be submitted to the Division.

6. As of August 24, 2007, Licensee has provided no documentation regarding the succession. Due to the failure of Licensee to provide the Division with succession documentation, the Division is unable to determine the current owner(s) of the deceased's interest.

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee shall pay Two Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$250.00) Dollars for the violation of **La. R.S 27:310(D) and L.A.C. 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(i)**.


2. The Division hereby agrees to accept a Two Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$250.00) Dollar penalty for the Licensee's violation of **La. R.S 27:310(D) and L.A.C. 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(i)**. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

3. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Licensee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.


5. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee must pay Two Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$250.00) Dollars within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
