#### COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and 190 Truck Stop, LLC d/b/a Grand Point Grand Casino (hereinafter, "Licensee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board sent a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Licensee, which Notice contains allegations of certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by said Notice are set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office on Monday, September 28, 2015.

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with said Notice;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

#### **STIPULATIONS**

1. On May 31, 2001, Licensee leased the land and improvements comprising its truck stop facility (the "licensed establishment") from Grand Point Grand Casino, LLC, who was represented by member, Eric Louque. The licensed establishment is located at 3415 Highway 3125, Paulina, Louisiana. Simultaneously, Licensee leased the bar and on-site restaurant to The

Stockpile Restaurant & Tavern, Inc., which is also owned by Mr. Louque. On October 21, 2003, the Louisiana Garning Control Board approved Licensee's Type 5 license. Licensee qualified for a maximum of thirty-five video garning devices at its licensed establishment.

- 2. On December 10, 2013, the Division received information that Licensee had two active video gaming licenses at the licensed establishment. Based on this information, the Division initiated an investigation of Licensee and the licensed establishment.
- 3. The Division's investigation revealed that the licensee failed to maintain ultimate supervision and control of the licensed establishment for a period of more than five (5) years. Additionally, on four (4) separate occasions, Licensee failed to notify the Division within ten (10) days of changes that affected the licensed establishment.

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- 1. In lieu of administrative action, Licensee will pay a penalty of SEVENTEEN THOUSAND and No/100 (\$17,000.00) DOLLARS for its violation of La. R.S. 27:402(10), La. R.S. 27:412(A)(1), (2), and (3), La. R.S. 27:412(B)(1) and (2), La. R.S. 412(C), La. R.S. 27:416(A), La. R.S. 27:416(B), La. R.S. 27:416(C)(3), La. R.S. 27:416(D)(4), La. R.S. 27:417(A)(2)(a), (b), (c), and (d), La. R.S. 27:418(A), La. R.S. 27:427(B)(1)(c), La. R.S. 27:427(B)(2), La. R.S. 27:427(D), LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(1)(a), LAC 42:XI.2405(C)(1), LAC 42:XI.2407(A)(6), LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(1), LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(2)(c), LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(4), and LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(c) and (f).
- 2. The Division hereby agrees that payment of a total penalty of SEVENTEEN THOUSAND and No/100 (\$17,000.00) DOLLARS shall be in full and final settlement of all matters set forth in the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this admitted violation in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of Licensee's suitability.

4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted

under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement

between the Division and Licensee, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and

supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the

parties.

This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the 6.

Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this

proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory,

but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether

to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

7. If approved, Licensee agrees to make full payment of the civil penalty within

fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

Licensee agrees that failure to meet this requirement shall result in immediate suspension of the

gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the

penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and

terms and conditions hereof.
