DECISION OF THE LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

IN RE: GENE A. PYRON NO. P040046601

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by Gene A. Pyron, Permit No. P040056749, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated January 6, 2015, in which his non-key gaming employee permit was revoked. At the time of the hearing, Mr. Pyron had a pending theft charge.

The Hearing Officer found that Mr. Pyron was disqualified from holding a permit because of a pending theft charge.

Mr. Pyron, in his appeal, alleges that the charge was "Nolle Prossed" and attached a copy of the "Minutes Report." The allegation and "Minutes Report" are not part of the record before the Board and cannot be considered.

We will remand this matter to the Hearing Officer for the introduction of evidence supporting this allegation. He will consider any new evidence and render a decision accordingly. Either party may then appeal.
