
A true and correct copy of the proposed Compromise and Settlement Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference for all purposes.

COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Riverbend Truckstops & Palace Casinos, Inc. d/b/a Terrebonne Truckstop & Casino (hereinafter, "Terrebonne") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Terrebonne, which Notice contains allegations of certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issue raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action has been set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Terrebonne are desirous of fully and finally settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. Terrebonne is a Type 5 licensed establishment located at 4067 West Park Avenue, Gray, Louisiana 70359.

2. On October 15, 2014, the Division conducted a compliance inspection at Terrebonne. At the time of the inspection, Terrebonne had a flyer and a billboard advertising daily cash drawings and "Hot Cash Giveaways."

3. The flyer for the promotion being offered was posted near the cashier's cage. The flyer only stated that the drawing would be within one hour of handing out tickets, that you must be present when the tickets are being handed out and when the winning ticket is called, and that they are not responsible for lost tickets.

4. The provision did not state all of the rules, terms, or conditions for the promotion, including, but not limited to: 1. When the cash drawings are conducted; 2. Amount of the cash prize or prize giveaways prior to any cash drawing; 3. Disclaimers, exclusions or stipulations in reference to the promotion; 4. Rules, terms, and conditions of the promotions; and 5. Promotion instructions.

5. Terrebonne's failure to display all rules, terms, and conditions of the promotions it offered during the month of October 2014 in a prominent manner inside the licensed establishment, as well as Terrebonne's promotional requirement that the participant be present when the winning ticket was called, violated **LAC 42:XI.2407(A)(8)(c) and (d)**.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. In lieu of Administrative Action of its Gaming License, Terrebonne will pay a civil penalty of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 (\$250.00) DOLLARS for its violation of **LAC 42:XI.2407(A)(8)(c) and (d)**.

2. The Division hereby agrees to accept Terrebonne's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action for the licensee's violation of LAC 42:XI.2407(A)(8)(c) and (d).

3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this admitted violation in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of Terrebonne's suitability.


4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Terrebonne, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties.


6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if the Hearing Officer approves this proposed settlement, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

7. If approved, Terrebonne agrees to make full payment of the civil penalty to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Terrebonne agrees that failure to meet this requirement shall result in immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action, until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Compromise and Settlement Agreement attached to the parties' Joint Motion for Approval of Compromise and Settlement Agreement be, and the same is hereby, **APPROVED**; that Riverbend Truckstops & Palace Casinos, Inc. d/b/a Terrebonne Truckstop & Casino must pay TWO HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 (\$250.00) DOLLARS to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Failure to do so shall result in the immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.
