## **DECISION OF THE LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD**

**IN RE: BURRITO'S GRILLE, LLC D/B/A BURRITO'S GRILLE  
NO. 3601216883**

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on a motion filed by Burrito's Grille, LLC d/b/a Burrito's Grille (the "Licensee") requesting reconsideration of the Notice of Revocation dated January 6, 2026, wherein its Type 2 video draw poker gaming license, No. 3601216883, was revoked. The basis of the revocation was due to the Licensee's failure to timely request an administrative hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the Licensee's receipt of a Notice of Recommendation of Revocation dated November 25, 2025, issued for failure to submit its Annual Licensee Form, appropriate fee, and required documents as required by gaming laws and regulations.

Counsel for the Licensee alleges that it inadvertently emailed its request for an administrative hearing to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board's former Appeal Docket Clerk instead of the Administrative Docket Clerk at the Louisiana Gaming Control Board's Administrative Hearing Office, and believed an administrative hearing was properly requested. Due to technical issues, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board was not aware of the Licensee's attempt to exercise its right to request an administrative hearing with the Louisiana Gaming Control Board's Administrative Hearing Office.

Louisiana Revised Statute 49:977.1(A) enumerates the grounds upon which an agency may rehear, reopen, or reconsider its decision and provides, in pertinent part:

- A. A decision or order in a case of adjudication shall be subject to rehearing, reopening, or reconsideration by the agency, within ten days from the date of entry. The grounds for action shall be one of the following:

- (4) There is other good ground for further consideration of the issues and the evidence in the public interest.

Based on the specific circumstances of this case, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board finds that the Licensee has presented good grounds for reconsideration in accordance with La. R.S. 49:997.1(A)(4). This matter will be forwarded to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board's Administrative Hearing Office for an administrative hearing on the merits of the allegations set forth in the Notice of Recommendation of Revocation dated November 25, 2025, where evidence may be introduced and a determination made in accordance with gaming laws and regulations. Either party may then appeal.

## ORDER

This matter having been considered by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board in open meeting of February 26, 2026:

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the request for reconsideration of the Notice of Revocation dated January 6, 2026, filed by Burrito's Grille, LLC d/b/a Burrito's Grille, No. 3601216883, is **GRANTED** and the matter is **FORWARDED** to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office for action in accordance with this decision.
