COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State

Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Holmes Seafood, Inc. d/b/a Holmes Seafood Restaurant

do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Division has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Revocation, Order

of Immediate Emergency Suspension, and Notice of Hearing to Holmes Seafood, Inc. d/b/a

Holmes Seafood Restaurant alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Revocation,

Order of Immediate Emergency Suspension, and Notice of Hearing were set for hearing on

September 23, 2009, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing

Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Holmes Seafood, Inc. d/b/a Holmes Seafood Restaurant

are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of

and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Revocation, Order of Immediate

Emergency Suspension, and Notice of Hearing:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby

agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

- 1. On or about July 21, 2009, the Office of State Police received information that Holmes Seafood, Inc. d/b/a Holmes Seafood Restaurant was operating without valid Louisiana Alcohol and Tobacco Control (ATC) permits.
- 2. An investigation revealed that permit numbers AR 260000019383-R and AR 260000019383-B were originally issued to Holmes Seafood on March 1, 2008, with expiration dates of February 28, 2009.
- 3. On or about July 22, 2009, a video draw poker compliance inspection was conducted at Holmes Seafood and the ATC permits were observed to be expired.
- 4. Between February 28, 2009, and July 21, 2009, Holmes Seafood generated net revenue of approximately \$20,275.50.
- 5. Holmes Seafood, Inc. d/b/a Holmes Seafood Restaurant failed to timely notify the Division of its failure to maintain valid ATC permits.
- 6. Holmes Seafood, Inc. d/b/a Holmes Seafood Restaurant is now current with its ATC permits and back in compliance.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Holmes Seafood, Inc. d/b/a Holmes Seafood Restaurant will pay a civil penalty of FOUR THOUSAND and No/100 (\$4,000.00) DOLLARS.
- 2. The Division will dismiss the Notice of Recommendation of Revocation, Order of Immediate Emergency Suspension, and Notice of Hearing.
- 3. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this Compromise and Settlement, Holmes Seafood, Inc. d/b/a Holmes Seafood Restaurant shall remit payment of the above referenced penalty to the Division.
- 4. The Division hereby agrees to accept Holmes Seafood, Inc. d/b/a Holmes Seafood Restaurant's payment of the above stated FOUR THOUSAND and No/100 (\$4,000.00) DOLLAR penalty in full and final settlement.
- 5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of the Licensee's suitability.
- 6. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

- 7. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Holmes Seafood, Inc. d/b/a Holmes Seafood Restaurant, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 8. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits. Failure to pay the penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement, and to comply with each term and condition listed herein, shall result in the immediate suspension of the Holmes Seafood, Inc. d/b/a Holmes Seafood Restaurant license without the necessity of further administrative action, until such time as the penalty is paid in full and Holmes Seafood, Inc. d/b/a Holmes Seafood Restaurant is in compliance with all terms and conditions.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
