
**ORDER**

**COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereafter "The Division"), Richard J. Seither (hereafter sometimes referred to as "Mr. Seither"), and Seither's Seafood, L.L.C. (hereafter sometimes referred to as "Seither's") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action (hereafter sometimes referred to as "the Notice"), dated November 2, 2006, to Seither's Seafood L.L.C. alleging certain violations of the Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the issues raised by the Notice are set for hearing on February 12, 2007 before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division, Seither's Seafood, L.L.C. and Richard J. Seither are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the Notice;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, and in consideration of the foregoing, the parties do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. In lieu of Administrative Action, Seither's Seafood, L.L.C. shall surrender its license with prejudice within 10 days of approval of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, and it will not be eligible to apply for any approval authorized by Louisiana Gaming Control Law for a period of five years from the date this Compromise and Settlement Agreement is approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

2. Seither's Seafood, L.L.C will not be eligible to re-apply, either individually or as shareholders, members, managing members, partners, managers, revenue, profit or income interest holders or as persons, who, in the opinion of the Division, may exercise significant influence over the operations of a Louisiana gaming licensee or permittee, for any approval authorized by the Louisiana Gaming Control Law for a period of five years from the date this Compromise and Settlement Agreement is approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

3. Seither's Seafood, L.L.C. and Mr. Seither agree not to directly, or through any natural or juridical person with whom they are affiliated, do business with any Louisiana casino for a period of sixty months commencing from the date this Compromise and Settlement Agreement is approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

4. The Division hereby agrees to accept Seither's Seafood, L.L.C. surrender of its license.

5. Richard J. Seither by his signature of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement acknowledges these stipulations and these prohibitions on behalf Seither's Seafood, L.L.C. and individually.

6. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration the violations alleged in the Notice in connection with any future violation(s), assessment of penalty or determination of the suitability of Seither's Seafood, L.L.C. or Richard J. Seither.

7. The form and substance of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

8. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division, Seither's and Mr. Seither pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

9. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed Compromise and Settlement Agreement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board no sooner than its regularly scheduled monthly meeting for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer.

10. Failure to fully comply with the terms and conditions of this Compromise and Settlement shall result in the immediate revocation of the Seither's license without further administrative action.
